



rectangle triangles (HRT) using **Template 16** and FOUR LEFT half rectangle triangles (HRT) using **Template 17** to complete. Once finished, you will have EIGHT segments as shown (**See Fig 60**). Trim to unfinished size 2.5" x 7.5". Press.
